## HATB - ATHLETES' FAQ

- Can I use public transport in the Engadine free of charge with the Athlete / Elite Card?
  - Public transport is **not** included with the Elite Card. However, most hotels and holiday apartments in St. Moritz and the Engadine offer "public transport included". Further information about this can be found at [www.stmoritz.com/de/hotels](http://www.stmoritz.com/de/hotels).
- Can individual lanes be reserved on the 400m track?
  - No, lanes cannot be reserved.
- How much does it cost to use the athletics facility?
  - Use of the athletics facility is free of charge for all professionals, elite and amateurs.
- Where can I book a physiotherapy treatment?
  - The MTZ therapeutic baths in St. Moritz (+41 81 833 30 62) offer physiotherapy and massages. Massages can also be booked at the OVAVERVA indoor pool (+41 081 836 61 00). Physiotherapy is furthermore available at Update Fitness, Physiozone, in St. Moritz village (+41 81 834 99 88).
- Can I ride my bike on the 400m track?
  - Basically not. But for participants in international competitions who do not have a pacemaker, cycling is allowed on the 400m track subject to prior approval by St. Moritz Tourism.
- Who is eligible for an Elite Card?
  - Athletes from abroad who belong to their national team and are preparing for a major international event such as the European Championship, World Cup or Olympic Games. For approval, their national association must submit written application in the athlete's name. For confirmation and follow-up of registration, the athlete must provide the name, place, date and result of the last international competition in which he or she participated.
  - Athletes from Switzerland who are holders of a Swiss Olympic Card (Gold, Silver, Bronze, Elite, National Talent).
- Which mountain railways can I use free of charge with the Elite Card?
  - The Corvatsch, Corviglia, Muottas Muragl and Diavolezza mountain railways can be used free of charge with the Elite Card.
